Q 7: How many Persons are in the one true God?

A: Three Persons.

Q 8: Who are they?

A: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Q 9: What is God?

A: God is a Spirit and does not have a body.

Q 10: Where is God?

A: God is everywhere.



1st Grade

Q 11: Can you see God?

A: No. I cannot see God, but He always sees me.

Q 12: Does God know everything?

A: Yes. Nothing can be hidden from God.

Q 13: Can God do all things?

A: Yes. God can do anything He wants.

Q 14: Where do you learn how to love and obey God?

A: Only in the Bible.

Q 15: Who wrote the Bible?

A: Men who were guided by the Holy Spirit.

Q 16: Who were our first parents?

A: Adam and Eve.

Q 18: What did God give Adam and Eve besides bodies?

A: He gave them souls that would never die.

2nd grade

Q 19: Do you have a soul as well as a body?

A: Yes. I have a soul that will never die

Q 20: How do you know that you have a soul?

A: Because God tells me so in the Bible.

Q 22: What is a covenant?

A: A bond between two or more persons.

Q 28: What is sin?

A: Sin is disobeying or not keeping God's law in any way

Q 29: What is disobeying God's law?

A: Doing what God says not to do.

Q 30: What is not keeping God's law?

A: Not being or not doing what God requires.

Q 31: How did Adam and Eve sin?

A: By eating the fruit God said not to eat.



3rd grade

Q 32: Who tempted Adam and Eve to sin?
A: Satan tempted Eve, and then she gave the fruit to Adam.

Q 33: What happened to Adam and Eve when they sinned?
A: They became sinful and were separated from God

Q 35: What effect did the sin of Adam sin have on you and all people?
A: We are all born with a sinful nature.

Q 36: What do we call the sinful nature we get from Adam?
A: Original Sin

Q 37: What does every sin deserve?
A: God's anger and punishment

Q 38: Can anyone go to heaven with this sinful nature?
A: No. Our hearts must be changed before we can believe in Jesus and go to heaven.

Q 39: What is this change of heart called?
A: Regeneration, or "being born again"

Q 40: Who can change a sinner's heart?
A: Only the Holy Spirit

Q 46: Did Jesus ever sin?
A: No. He perfectly obeyed God all the time.

4th grade

Q 47: How did Jesus suffer?
A: By becoming human and making atonement for our sins

Q 48: What is the atonement?
A: By suffering and dying for His people, Jesus took the punishment we deserve

Q 49: What does God promise to do in the covenant?
A: To justify and sanctify all God's people

Q 50: What happens in justification?
A: God forgives all my sins and accepts me as righteous through Jesus.

Q 51: What happens in sanctification?
A: God makes the hearts and actions of believers holy.

Q 52: For whom did Jesus obey and suffer?
A: For those the Father has given Him

Q 53: How did Jesus live on earth?
A: He was poor and suffered

Q 54: How did Jesus die?
A: In pain and shame on the cross.



5th grade

Q 55: Who will be saved?

A: Only those who truly repent of their sins and believe in Jesus.

Q 56: What happens when you repent?

A: I must be sorry for my sin, and hate my sin and turn away from sin.

Q 57: What happens when you believe in Jesus?

A: I trust in Jesus alone to save me

Q 58: Can you repent and believe in Jesus on your own?

A: No - I must have the Holy Spirit's help.

Q 59: How can you get the Holy Spirit's help?

A: God told us to pray to Him for the Holy Spirit

Q 60: When did Jesus die?

A: Almost 2000 years ago

Q 109: What is prayer?

A: Prayer is praising God, giving thanks for all his blessings, and asking him for the things he has promised in the Bible.

Q 111: What did Christ give us to teach us about prayer?

A: The Lord's Prayer.

Q 112: What is the Lord's Prayer?

A: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil." (Matthew 6:9-13 ESV)
