Jajuan McNeil Hired as Director of Children's Ministry

After initiating a search process in January 2021, Redeemer is excited to welcome Jajuan McNeil as our new Director of Children's Ministry.



Jajuan and his family – Joya, Cali (7), and Deuce (5) – have been members of Redeemer since 2017. Jajuan comes to us via Gary, IN and Oxford, MS. While a student at Ole Miss, Jajuan created, programmed, and executed an afterschool program for kids, networking with churches in the area to provide resources while developing leaders.

He has been regularly involved in children's ministry, mentoring, and coaching in a variety of contexts, including as a faithful Sunday School

teacher, Upside Down leader, and Disability Ministry buddy at Redeemer. Jajuan holds a Master of Arts in Integrated Marketing Communications, a Bachelor of Arts in Journalism, and comes to us from Progressive Insurance.

Since 2014, our children's ministry has more than doubled (growing from 40 to 150 children on Wednesday nights from 2014 to 2019). Jajuan's profound gifts in discipleship, equipping and encouraging children and families, and administration/organization make him a fantastic fit for our church. We are thrilled to welcome him to the staff.

New Hires on Our Youth Ministry Team

Ann Chestnut will serve as a part-time High School Ministry Assistant with Rooted to disciple our high school girls. She has served with Redeemer Youth for the past 8 years and has done an amazing job.
