## **Reflection Quote**

"We must wrestle with the tension between monastery and mission. We are not called to remain within cloistered walls, giving ourselves to prayer apart from social engagement with the world. Nor are we called to perpetually and indiscriminately be consumed with being active in the world. We are called to hold this dynamic tension before God. Why? Very simply, unless we do so, we have nothing to offer the world. The deeply formed mission is fundamentally about becoming a particular person and offering that to the world. This kind of mission is not just about activity; it's about being Christ for another. Anyone who belongs to Jesus is indwelled by his Spirit. This indwelling life is not simply for the purpose of private, mystical experiences; it's also for the purpose of being shared with the world around us. Deeply formed mission is first about who we are becoming before what we are doing. Our most effective strategy in reaching a world for Christ is grounded in the kind of people we are being formed into. The quality of our presence is our mission. And the good news is that Jesus doesn't wait for us to be perfect before inviting us into mission. On the contrary, being "perfect" disqualifies us from partnering with Jesus in mission. When you read the Bible, you'll see again and again that God doesn't call perfect people."

# SERMON QUESTIONS

- Read the reflection quote in the bulletin. What stands out to you? Have you experienced the tension between monastery and mission? Do you naturally gravitate to either pole?
- The book of Acts will repeatedly remind us of our identity as witnesses of Jesus to a
  watching and waiting world! Why is this necessary? Important?
- Read 1 Thessalonians 1:1-12. It provides a helpful backdrop to Acts 17. One way
  Paul attested to the Lordship of Jesus was through his behavior while in Thessalonica. Describe it. Contrast it with the jealous Jews, the crowd, and the men of rabble.
  Why do you think he tells them to remember his conduct?
- When have you seen God use your integrity, friendliness, peacefulness, faithfulness, and diligence to cause non-believers to take notice?
- Paul does not stop at good behavior. He proceeds to teach them a better word the Scriptures. Why might this be a showdown between the "words of God" and the
  "words of Caesar?"
- Everyone has a worldview. According to Greg Koukl, worldview entails answering
  four questions. Do you remember them? When Paul unpacks the necessity of Jesus'
  coming, death, resurrection, how was he placing Jesus at the center of reality and
  salvation? How is the story of Jesus a much better story than the false worldviews
  people embrace?
- Paul is accused of proclaiming another king, who is higher than Caesar. This was treason. Yet, it is true. How is Jesus a better king? Where do we see this in the text? Where do we see this in 1-2 Thessalonians? How might we remind the watching and waiting world of this?
- Pastor Villodas reminds us that we best do mission by first becoming the type of people who abide in Jesus. Have you personally marveled at the goodness of our King? Have the words of your King proven better than all others? Have you found him to be impeccably holy and magnetizing? What would it look like to cultivate this?


