SERMON QUESTIONS

- Reflect on our call to worship. God promises David that a king whose kingdom
 will endure forever will come from his offspring! Why could this not be fulfilled
 in Solomon? Who is it?
- Have you ever experienced Deja Vu? It's a French phrase that means, "Already seen." Jesus is not the first king to travel over the brook of Kidron and the Mount of Olives! Who else traveled that route, albeit in the opposite direction?
- Why should we strongly consider Jesus' words, "I am he" (v.5 and 6), to be another important I AM statement?
- How does Jesus show us that he is our courageous king? He fully knows what is about to happen to him. Does he run away or walk towards his destiny? Why is this good news for us?
- How does Jesus show us that he is our caring (and repairing) king? How does
 he respond to Peter? What about Malchus (Luke 22:52)? Why is this good
 news for us? When have you experienced his care and repair after you've
 blown it?
- What does Jesus mean when he says, "I must drink the cup the Father has given him?" What's in that cup (Isaiah 51)?
- The synoptic writers tell us the precise weapons the soldiers are carrying (clubs and swords). John tells us these things take place in a garden, a garden Jesus frequently visited with his disciples. Where have we seen judgment, swords, and a garden together before in the Bible? Jesus will submit himself to divine judgment so that many, who side with him, might be freed from the coming wrath of God. Read John 18:8-9 and 18:14.
- His substitutionary atonement saves us and secures the above blessings for us.
 Have you trusted in the King?
- Spend some time marinating on the reflection quote taken from a hymn written by Anne Cousin (1824 - 1906).
